Dear Pastor and Congregation:

I am the newly elected secretary for our Lake City Area Food Shelf. I am contacting you as I have been asked to write letters to all of our local churches on behalf of the food shelf. We are extremely fortunate here as we are able to give generously to people who need our services. Our shelves, in the past, have been filled, and sometimes, even overflowing. The Covid pandemic changed that.

We order a lot of our food from an organization called Channel One. We used to have a list of ten pages to choose from now we are down to about three. Channel One is also facing challenges and one of their problems is they cannot get the food either. The trickle down from this is very noticeable. Our food shelf has had to purchase our staples from local businesses. These include items such as eggs, butter, flour, sugar, bread, soups, beans, toilet paper and diapers. We are so fortunate that these local businesses not only donate what they can, they also give us a price break on many things we need to buy.

All that being said, we are wondering if you and your congregation would be willing to donate a few of the necessities to us. We are in need of the following:

Flour, Sugar, and Cooking Oil
Coffee - 1-pound and 2-pound sizes
Tea - green or black
Pasta - 1 pound of elbow, rotini, penne, egg noodles, etc.
Pasta Sauce - 15 - 20 ounces of canned
Dish Soap - 24-ounce size (or similar)
Men's and Women's Deodorant
Cream of Mushroom, Cream of Chicken and Chicken Noodle soup
Chili beans, baked beans, dry beans
Canned Corn
Diapers (size 0 to 5)
Toilet Paper

Please know that we appreciate all you have done for us in the past. These are truly difficult times for all. This is not to put a strain on anyone else - we ask only that people give if they can. Items can be dropped off at the food shelf any Tuesday (1:00 - 3:00), Thursday (9:00 - 11:00) or the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday of the month (9:00 - 11:00 AM). Our address is 600 South 8<sup>th</sup> Street. If you would prefer, someone could always come to pick up any items you are able to collect.

He will be gone June 11<sup>th</sup> and the week to follow to take Matthew to a visit at the Naval academy. He is looking for a visiting Pastor to take his place. There will be a meeting in early June for the elders of both churches with Pastor to review the confirmation program and make it more meaningful for the kids.

Gerhardt Kohrs came to present an idea he would like to donate to the cemetery. He had plans to put up a memorial to the unborn at the front of the cemetery. The council approved it.

The Secretary's report was approved.

The Treasurer's report was approved.

The Financial Secretary's report was approved.

The trustees are still trying to contact the right people to get a bid on the roof. One company was planning on it but found out they are not licensed to do the job. An electrician will redo the outlets under the kitchen counter on separate breakers for better use during big events. \$1,400 was spent on the rental on Prairie Street for wiring the bedrooms with outlets in the upstairs. The basement windows will be resealed and some landscaping will be done to keep water from seeping in.

The Discipleship committee will send out notices to former pastors to save the date for our Anniversary November 5<sup>th</sup>. \$500 was sent to adopt a student now as there were matching funds available. \$110 was sent to Mission Central and a little over \$600 went to general missions.\

The Cemetery was mowed and a meeting with Glander excavating will be set up to discuss putting in a gravel road. A meeting will be set up with the people who built the shed to move it to the back of the cemetery property.

There was no new or old business that had not been discussed and President Stehr adjourned the meeting. We closed with the Lord's Prayer.


