Treasurer's Report: Read and approved

Financial Secretary's Report: Read and approved

Trustee's Report: A motion was made and seconded to have the blacktop on the driveway redone at a cost of approximately \$4,800. The carpet needs to be replaced as well and will be brought up at the voters meeting. Bids to replace the carpet were \$11,500 to \$6,000 depending on which areas to redone. Some tiles were replaced in the fellowship hall due to water damage. Several light bulbs were replaced in the church. The Prairie Street house had landscaping done to keep water from coming in and damaging the foundation. The 6<sup>th</sup> Street house had a leaky faucet fixed and the air conditioner cleaned and repaired. Just for Kix will again be renting the basement for dance lessons.

Elder's Report: They will be reviewing the list of members and trying to decide what to do with members that live out of state or do not attend. They want to make to membership list more up to date. They may be looking at reviewing the constitution after the first of the year.

Education Report: There will be no Sunday school at this time as there are only 3 little ones. Hopefully there will be a preschool class next year. There are two eighth graders, six seventh graders, and two 6<sup>th</sup> graders to be taking confirmation classes. Michelle will be teaching the 6<sup>th</sup> graders. 
