February 14 - 7:00PM at Saint Peter's⁺

In Week 1 of Lent we are drawn to Calvary to receive **hope**.

We contemplate how to live lives of hope as we remember Christ went to the cross to save us forevermore.

February 21 – 7:00PM at Bethany

In Week 2 of Lent we are drawn to Calvary to receive **love**.

We contemplate how to live lives of love in response to the love Christ showed us on the cross.

February 28 - 7:00PM at Saint Peter's

In Week 3 of Lent we are drawn to Calvary to receive **peace**.

We contemplate how to live lives of peace in our hearts, souls and minds through Christ,
who brought peace between us and God by the cross.

March 6 – 7:00PM at Bethany

In Week 4 of Lent we are drawn to Calvary to deepen our **trust**.

We contemplate how to live lives of trust in God, who entrusted his Son, Jesus, on the cross for our sake.

March 13 - 7:00PM at Saint Peter's

In Week 5 of Lent we are drawn to Calvary to grow in **perseverance**.

We contemplate how to live lives of perseverance in the midst of strife in the name of Jesus,
who endured the cross to the very end for us all.

March 20 – 7:00PM at Bethany

For Palm Sunday, we follow Jesus as he enters Jerusalem in humility on his way to Calvary.

In word and song, we contemplate how to live lives of **humility**, guided by Christ and the cross.

The Rite of Confirmation will be celebrated at both churches as well.

March 24 – 9:00AM at Bethany⁺ and 10:30 at Saint Peter's⁺

Join us for a very special Seder Meal for Maundy Thursday.

Those gathered will engage in the rituals associated with the Passover meal Jesus shared with his disciples,
the traditional foods and the meanings behind them will be presented,
and an ancient song of deliverance will be sung.

The meal will end with Holy Communion, pointing to the Lamb who has slain for us on the cross.

March 28 – Time To Be Determined at Bethany⁺

On Good Friday we ponder Christ's death on the cross as a sacrifice for us all.

In word and song, we contemplate how to live lives of **sacrifice**, guided by Christ and the cross.

March 29 – 7:00 PM at Saint Peter's

On Easter Sunday we celebrate that the crucified Christ is raised from the dead to new life.

In word and song, we contemplate how to live a new **life**, guided by the risen Christ.

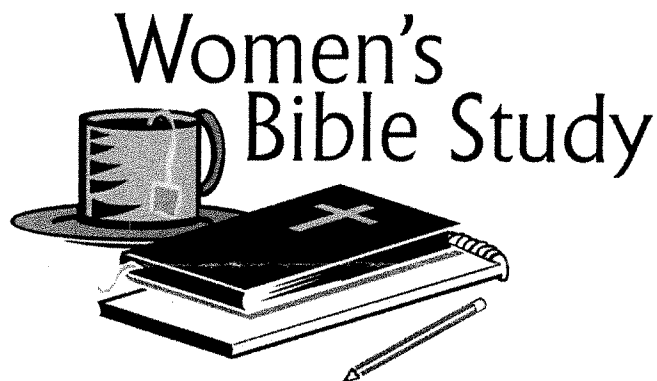
March 31 – 8:00AM at Bethany⁺ and 10:30 at Saint Peter's⁺

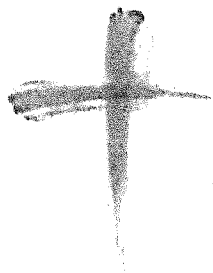

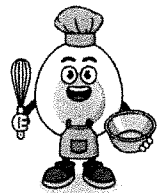
